Squamous cells describe thin, flat cells that line the inner surface of the entire esophagus and this type of cancer may occur anywhere in the esophagus, though most are found in the upper half.

Basaloid squamous cell carcinoma Basaloid squamous cell carcinoma is a high-grade variant of SCC composed of both basaloid and squamous components (Barnes et al., 2005). It is an aggressive, rapidly growing tumor characterized by an advanced stage at the time of diagnosis (cervical lymph node metastases) and a poor prognosis.
